Progress

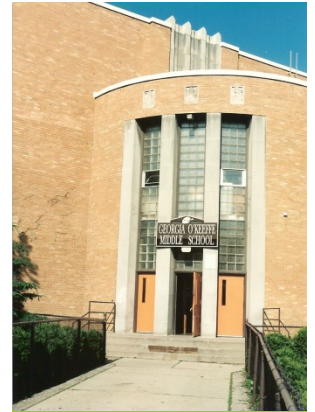

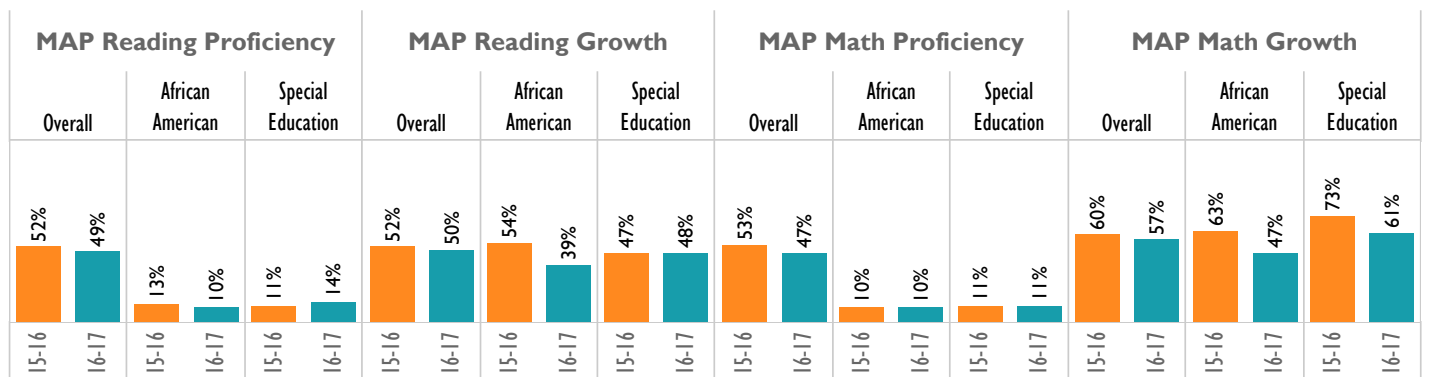

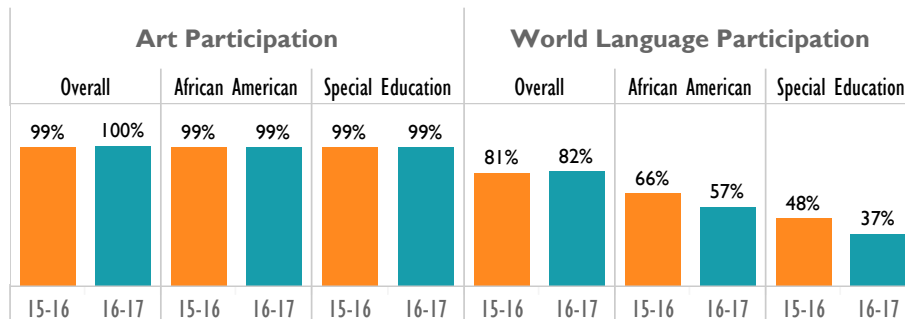
